- Hemming tape
- Double-sided tape that keeps clothes in place
- Wrinkle release spray
- Static cling spray
- Lint roller
- Stain remover pen
- Baby powder (to absorb spilled oil)
- Rubbing alcohol or hand sanitizer (for stains)
- White cloths
- Cotton rounds
- Chalk to match the bride's dress (white or off-white—to cover tough stains)
- Moleskin and/or anti-blister balm
- Gel insoles for heels
- Super glue (for quick shoe repair)
- Sandpaper (for anti-slip soles)
- Corsage pins
- Extra jewelry (including earring backs)
